# Press Release

The Pembroke Hill School wins the Under 3<sup>rd</sup> & Under 5<sup>th</sup> grade sections of the Missouri State Scholastic Chess Championships on February 28th, 2009.

The Pembroke Hill School fielded 9 players in the Under 3<sup>rd</sup> grade section and secured a first place finish by a whopping margin. Victories like this are certainly unexpected but with this group of third graders anything was possible. The team was buoyed by five strong performances listed below.

The Under 5<sup>th</sup> grade section was preserved by seven brave warriors. Tension was high as the squad was in 2<sup>nd</sup> place practically the entire event. Sweeping virtually every game in the last round pushed them ahead of the competition.

This year's tournament was placed at the Capitol Plaza Hotel in Jefferson City, Missouri. There were 515 players who participated in this tournament making it the largest one-day scholastic event ever in the state (sans any National event).

The Pembroke teams scored the highest point totals of any team in the entire tournament (19.5 & 19). That is impressive. Here's a recap: 2 state titles, 8 individual finalists, and 2 medal winners. It was the third straight Under 5<sup>th</sup> grade division win and the 2<sup>nd</sup> straight championship for the Under 3<sup>rd</sup> grade division. That's a full plate!
